



Executive MBA Scholarships

Manchester Metropolitan University Business School

Manchester Metropolitan University Business School is pleased to announce the availability of a limited number of scholarships for the Executive MBA programme (**value up to £2,000 per award**).

Eligibility

These scholarships are available to **self-funded/partially funded** students.

*Note: If you are **self-funded** you will be meeting the costs of your MBA studies by yourself. This may be through drawing on savings or arranging a loan. If you are **partially funded** you will receive some financial support that does not need to be repaid, (this does not include any other MMU scholarship). For example, your employer may be paying some of your fees. If you are **fully funded** then the whole cost of your tuition is being met by a funding source which does not need to be repaid. For example, your employer is covering all the costs of your MBA studies.*

If you are in receipt of any other MMU bursary/scholarship (for example a family discount or VC Scholarship) you may still apply for a Business School Executive MBA Scholarship subject to the following conditions:

- *That any awarded MMU bursary/scholarship does not exceed the maximum value of the Business School Executive MBA Scholarship (£2,000).*
- *That the combined value of a Business School Executive MBA Scholarship plus an MMU bursary/scholarship will not exceed the maximum value of the Business School Executive MBA Scholarship (£2,000).*

How to apply

Before applying for a scholarship, you must apply and receive an offer of a place on the Executive MBA programme. You must accept the offer and confirm your place for October or February entry.

Then, you must submit a **1,000-word essay entitled “My Contribution to the MBA”**. Your application should: (1) demonstrate your understanding of the MBA; (2) use examples from your work experience to evidence your management style, skills and competencies; (3) show how you will add value to the programme and the experience of your fellow students; and (4) indicate the steps you will take to become an alumni advocate for the programme

The essay must be submitted to: MBA@mmu.ac.uk

Deadline

You are advised to apply as soon as you have confirmed your place on the Executive MBA programme. However, we will consider applications that are submitted up to one month after your studies have begun.

The MBA scholarship board meets monthly and will make the final decision for each award.
